
A good service and short delivery times are the strengths of the company. The design team invests all of their passion and craftsmanship in the development of the lamps.

axis71 can be considered a true 'couturier' in lighting, furniture and objects. The roots of axis71 can be traced back to 1971, when it started out as a gallery in Paris. Thirty years later, Patrick Vossen expanded the company with a lot of enthusiasm.

The original name axis got the suffix '71' added to it, as an ode to the birth year 1971. In the last decade, axis71 has become a household name in lighting design.

The collections are distributed through a network of 'Ambassadors' in several European countries (Germany, United Kingdom, Poland, France, Spain, the Netherlands) and the United States. Axis71 also has its agents in Dubai, Israël en St-Barthélemy. Their reputation among a number of architecturals definitely contributes to the expansion of a sales network.

The beautifully decorated showroom in Hoegaarden is situated in a refurbished dairy from the forties.

Carlo Nason

"We can direct the light where we want".



The Italian designer Carlo Nason was born in 1935 in Murano, into a family of expert glassmakers.

His father, Vincenzo Nason, ran the famous glass company Nason/Moretti and opened a second glass company under the name Vincenzo Nason & C in 1941. From an early age, the young Nason was trained in the art of glassblowing, learning both the properties of the material and the craft techniques used in glass moulding and decoration.

The first objects designed by Nason date from 1959 and are part of a collection of blow-moulded vases produced by V Nason & C. Today, they are housed in the Corning Museum of Glass in Corning, New York.


Driven by his passion for design, particularly for cleanliness and geometry of form, he decided in the 1960s to distance himself from the family business, which mainly specialised in highly traditional and ornate decorative objects. Nason shifted his focus to the design of glass lighting in a modernist language.


Nason intended to produce his first models himself in small series, but soon his spirit of experimentation and innovation attracted the attention of Murano glass manufacturer A. V. Mazzega, and the company invited him to collaborate on new collections. The partnership lasted from 1965 until the 1980s and resulted in a range of iconic lighting designs still in demand today. Alongside the collaboration with A. V. Mazzega, Nason also created designs for other leading Murano glassworks companies.


He continued to create designs in the 1980s and 1990s, and also worked as a consultant for Casinos Austria, and later as a photographer. His work has been exhibited over the decades in numerous museums and art and design galleries in Paris, Milan and New York.

Ala Series 1969

I designed Ala at the end of the 60s, it was produced for the first time between 69 and 70. It took its name from a gesture that everyone can do by crossing their hands to imitate the movement of birds wings or when, as in the Chinese Puppet game, we project on the wall the shadow of a bird in flight. A cylinder that contains the light source, two disks folded and joined together. All the magic is there. There are no hinges or bearings, everything happens through the geometric game of balanced elements. Ala has an infinite number of positions and consequent shapes.



Alberto Nason









Various exhibitions, awards and various publications in newspapers.She collaborates with prestigious companies in the sector including axis71.


She exhibits at the XXI International DESIGN Exhibition at the Milan Triennale, a permanent display with the best designers of the 20th century.



The designer Stéphane Lebrun drew his inspiration for the design of the bamboo structures in his Nao Mai line from his travel in Asia.



His concepts are relevant to all aspects of design, from interior design to the development of objects, furniture and lighting. His perception of the harmony of geometry is timeless and universal.


